

# First 3 hours

## What should I include in my *Emergency GO Binder*?

- names, addresses, phone numbers for local/ward/stake/out-of-state contacts
- maps to rendezvous locations
- birth certificates and/or adoption certificates
- marriage certificate
- copies of driver's licenses
- passports
- social security cards
- church membership records
- current ward list
- recent family photo
- info sheet on each family member: physical description, photo, and any other info that would help locate them during an emergency.
- copies of your credit cards front and back
- insurance cards (order extras or copy front and back)
- list of current prescriptions
- immunization records
- health insurance policy
- homeowners insurance policy
- photos and descriptions of valuables that can't be taken with you (for insurance claims)
- warranties on big household items
- auto insurance policy
- life insurance policy
- bank statements and/or account numbers
- retirement statements and/or account numbers
- internet passwords (banking, personal, work etc)
- utility statements and/or account numbers
- work/tax documents that would be difficult to replace
- vehicle ID numbers and/or copy of title
- deeds/title to houses and real property
- spare keys to houses, cars, mailboxes, etc...
- cash – small bills

You may also want to add a prioritized list of household items to grab in case of evacuation (in addition to 72-hour emergency kits)...such as family photos, journals, family history stuff, irreplaceable valuables, cameras, computer back-up, etc.

**\*\*The *GO Binder* should be stored in a fire-safe, easily accessible location, with copies in another location outside of the home.\*\***
